In its sixth consecutive year, Manhattan in the Mountains will work with 50 young classical musicians from July 23-August 13. , cellists, and pianists, ages 13 and up, working under the guidance of an internationally renowned faculty.</p> <p><b>National Dance Institute</b>– 8<sup>th</sup> annual Mountaintop Summer Residency for 2 weeks with local children aged 9-13, culminating in a performance on July 22<sup>nd</sup>.</p> <p><b>Broadway in the Mountains:</b> From July 10-22, students will receive intense instruction in singing, dancing and acting, with a culminating showcase on the last Saturday night of the residency.</p> <p><b>Chase Brock Experience:</b> This Brooklyn-based contemporary dance company, in residence from May 8-21, is dedicated to developing and presenting the work of Chase Brock. A performance from its repertoire will be presented on May 20<sup>th</sup>.</p>
